### *Local, Sustainable, Beautiful Hardwood*

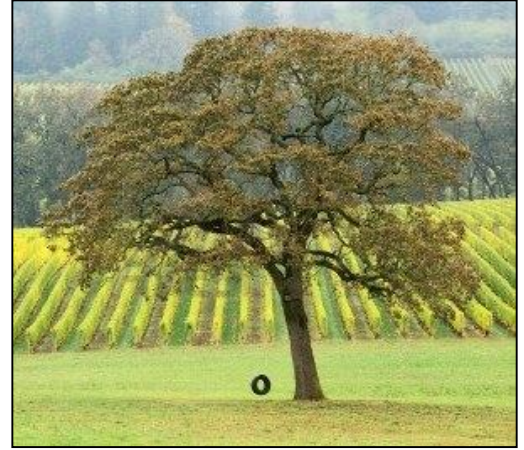
Sustainable Northwest Wood's Willamette Valley Walnut is sourced from backyard salvage projects in communities near Portland, OR.

#### **PROPERTIES:**

- Kiln-dried
- Exquisite color and grain
- Durable, hard wood is excellent for flooring, cabinetry and furniture

**COMMUNITY:** Our Walnut is sourced from small mills in the Willamette Valley and Portland metro area.

**ECOSYSTEM:** Walnut was introduced to the Pacific Northwest by early settlers, who brought the root stock of this much-loved tree from England. Today, many of these original trees are nearing the end of their natural life spans. Others are succumbing to a beetle-transmitted disease that is affecting walnuts throughout the Pacific Northwest.

These dead and dying trees become hazards that must be removed from their urban or backyard settings before they damage people or property.

Sustainable Northwest Wood partners with small mills that are salvaging the wood and turning it into useful, beautiful products.

#### **AVAILABILITY:**

- 4/4 through 8/4 kiln-dried hardwood lumber
- Live-edge slabs
- Willamette Valley Walnut flooring in 4", 5", and 6" face widths, kiln-dried and end-matched, lengths up to 12'
